Registration for quilts displayed in our 2018 show will start next month!

Registration begins on Thursday, January 4^{th} and will end Monday, March 19^{th} . No registrations will be accepted after registration ends. The registration committee will be nagging and pestering everyone to get their entries completed early. One of us will be at all the meetings to take pictures and answer any and all questions.

Each FCQ member may submit up to five (5^*) quilts. Keep priorities in mind—the church has limited our display space, and we may have to reject some of the priority 4 and 5 quilts. If you really want one of your quilts in the show, give it your priority 1 or 2.

In addition, each member can enter a single quilt made for our Project Linus Alphabet Challenge. All of the challenge quilts will be displayed in some fashion.

* There is a possibility we will have even less display space for this show. This will mean that each member will only be able to submit up to four (4) quilts. We hope to have an answer to this issue before registration begins.


