Mary's lecture is entitled "UFO Assault Tactics." This should be a fun lecture with lots of helpful tips about how to make better progress on the many UFO quilters tend to accumulate.

On Saturday July 28, Mary will be teaching a full day workshop "Scrappy String Star." This workshop will be held at the Gary J. Arthur Community Center in Glenwood. Scrappy String Star is a large scale 8-pointed star -- blocks about 18" square -- which uses up lots of bits and incorporates a little bit of y-seam piecing to assemble the diamonds. Mary will teach the Set-In Piecing Simplified technique. Four of these blocks make a good size lap quilt! The class will be held from 9:00am-4:00pm and costs \$50. Registration is open now. 
