Tiny Art Quilts (TAQ) – A fool proof method for making a small keepsake quilt

Have you ever wanted to make a keepsake quilt for yourself or a gift but didn't have the time or energy to invest in a large quilt? The answer is a tiny art quilt. From a photo of your travels, of your pet, of your house, or anything else that strikes your fancy, you will design and create your own small art quilt (around 12" x 12"). This small quilt can be used as a wall hanging, a pillow, the centerpiece for a larger quilt, the focus of a bag or designer jacket.

In this one-day workshop you will design and make your own tiny art quilt. In the morning you will design your quilt from a treasured photo and select your fabrics. In the afternoon, you will make your tiny art quilt. You should be able to mostly complete. Binding or incorporating your TAQ into a bigger project will be done on your own.

What is needed for this class:

- Printed Photo (Please share it with me ahead of time to make sure it will be suitable for a TAQ. Also, do not print photos from the internet unless you know they are free from copyright.) (I have photos of many African animals that you can use, just let me know).
- 2. Fabrics that you would like to use to create your quilt. Think out of the box. Maybe you would like your doggie to read blue or create a pink elephant. The key is to have a range of light to dark in a given hue. I will bring a variety of fabrics as well.
- 3. Batting and backing. I will have some extras if you need it.
- 4. Coordinating threads.
- 5. Sewing machine that allows you to lower the feed dogs.
